To be eligible to apply, you must:

- Be a Southern Santa Barbara County area high school senior graduating in 2009 (*Carpinteria, Santa Barbara, or Goleta areas*) who has attended school in Santa Barbara County for at least four of the six secondary grade years

AND

- Be planning to Major in Art or an Art-related field at college

ART JUDGING COMPETITION: January 2009 TBA

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This is a program for the traditional fine arts, including painting, drawing, sketching, still photography, design, furniture, and sculpture. We cannot accept films, video, 100% computer-generated/digital art, or any type of performance art.

After applications are evaluated, only a select number of students will be asked to deliver their portfolio of art pieces to the Judging Competition. Applicants will receive a letter in December 2008 regarding Judging selections and details.

If you are selected for the Art Judging Competition, your art materials must be delivered and picked up on the specified date at the Ridley-Tree Art Education Center at 1600 Santa Barbara Street. Note: Your portfolio will be limited to four pieces or less. The Scholarship Foundation is **not** responsible for unclaimed Portfolios.

Portfolio guidelines: Post-it notes must **cover** the artist's signature/name on the **front** of each piece of art, so be sure that the artist's name is on the **back** of each exhibited item. Judges request that the approximate date each piece was created be on the front of each piece.

The scholarship winners are selected from the Judged group only. Approximately 13 scholarships will be awarded. All scholarship winners are required to attend the Art Scholarship Reception in January 2009 and display the same portfolio pieces entered in the competition.
