

Guillaume de Zwirek, CEO and founder of Artera (formerly WELL Health), started the company in 2015 with a singular mission: make healthcare No. 1 in customer service. Today, Artera is a leader in digital patient communications and a two-time Best in KLAS winner in Patient Outreach.

Artera delivers a platform-level patient communications solution that integrates across a health system's tech stack to deliver patients a simple, cohesive communications experience while reducing workload for healthcare staff. By unifying disjointed communications and information into a single channel for patients (texting, email, and IVR), Artera fuels healthcare providers to deliver healthier patients, more efficient staff, and more profitable organizations.

Under Gui's leadership, the Artera platform now helps more than 500 health systems facilitate 2.2 billion messages for more than 68 million patients. Artera has been recognized by *Forbes* as one of the nation's Best Startup Employers (No. 10) and has appeared on Deloitte's Tech Fast 500 and the *Inc.* 5000 Fastest-Growing Private Companies in America lists.

Before founding WELL Health, Gui worked at Google and Graphiq.com (acquired by Amazon).

Gui graduated from the University of Southern California with bachelor's degrees in classical guitar performance and business administration. He is a six-time Ironman athlete.

YARDI



Founded by Anant Yardi in 1982, Yardi has been developing and supporting real estate technology for four decades. The company began as a small startup focused on

quality software and customer satisfaction. In 1984, it released its first real estate software, Microsoft DOS-based Basic Property Management. Keeping pace with technological developments, the company introduced Microsoft Windows-based platforms during the 1990s. With the emergence of cloud computing, Yardi created its hosting service team and launched its first browser-based software in 2001.

Today, Yardi has more than 8,500 staff in 45 offices across North America, Europe, Asia, the Middle East, and Australia. The company focuses on the unique needs of the real estate industry and works closely with its clients to ensure its software evolves with industry trends. Yardi's client-driven products and services enable real estate companies of all sizes to manage their entire business on one connected, mobile platform. With clients managing assets in more than 80 countries, Yardi maintains a strong and growing presence in the global real estate market.

Yardi remains privately held and headquartered on the South Coast and boasts more than 1,300 California employees, most of whom are based in Santa Barbara and Oxnard. Its employees enjoy 100 percent healthcare premium coverage, tuition reimbursement, profit sharing, parental leave, and other benefits. Employee review company Glassdoor has repeatedly named Yardi as one of the best places to work in the United States, and founder Anant Yardi as one of the highest-rated CEOs in the country.

The company also maintains a long-standing philanthropy program to give back to the communities in which its employees live and work. Yardi fosters community projects in education, social and medical services, sustainability, and disaster relief. The company supports hundreds of nonprofit organizations worldwide, including more than 50 in the Santa Barbara area. Along the South Coast, Yardi has supported projects as diverse as sustainability research at UCSB, a children's museum, programs for adults with disabilities, small business mentoring, and local food banks. Its commitment to sustainability and energy conservation has earned the company several ENERGY STAR Partner of the Year Awards, including prestigious Sustained Excellence Awards in 2021, 2022, and 2023.

2023 EXCELLENCE IN SERVICE HONOREE

FOODBANK OF SANTA BARBARA COUNTY



The Foodbank of Santa Barbara County's mission is to end hunger and transform the health of the community through good nutrition. For 40 years the Foodbank has served as the primary hunger-relief and food empowerment organization in the region. Through its

network of 200-plus nonprofit partners, the Foodbank distributes some 10 million pounds of food (including 40 percent fresh produce) in an average year.

The Foodbank serves all food-insecure, low-income residents of Santa Barbara County, including high-need areas of Santa Barbara, Carpinteria, the Santa Ynez Valley, Lompoc, Santa Maria, and Los Alamos. Approximately 190,000 unduplicated individuals access Foodbank services each year. That number grew to more than 235,000 people during the pandemic.

The Foodbank moves clients "from Hunger into Health" with a holistic, bottom-up approach:

- 1. To provide immediate hunger relief, the organization distributes a variety of healthful and culturally ubiquitous foods through warehouses in Santa Barbara and Santa Maria. The Foodbank is a member of Feeding America and utilizes food system collaborations to procure healthy food.
- 2. To provide clients with the foundational knowledge and resources to improve their health, the Foodbank hosts a suite of nutrition education programs for children and families, provides CalFresh/SNAP outreach, and teaches food literacy skills to address the root causes of poor nutrition.
- 3. To build communitywide stability and resilience, the Foodbank has incorporated disaster preparedness and relief into its strategic operations. In 2019, the Foodbank championed the creation of a countywide Disaster Feeding Plan in partnership with countywide stakeholders, which continues to guide the organization's comprehensive response to economic instability resulting from the pandemic. As the county's sole distributor of USDA foods and the lead organization of VOAD-SBC (FEMA's Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster program), the Foodbank is responsible for coordinating nonprofit response efforts when disaster strikes the county.

The Foodbank's direct-to-client programs are tailored to serve those who struggle most with food insecurity and its associated poor health outcomes, including the working poor, older adults on fixed incomes, children, migratory farmworkers, and the unhoused population. All participants enjoy programs and services free of cost.

2023 PIONEER HONOREE

JOHN GREATHOUSE



John Greathouse is a serial entrepreneur, writer, venture investor, and UC Santa Barbara professor. He has held a number of senior executive positions with successful startups in Santa Barbara, spearheading transactions that have generated more than \$350 million in shareholder value.

As a venture capitalist, John has deployed roughly \$100 million on behalf of approximately 60 ventures, which collectively have created more than \$2 billion in shareholder value. Santa Barbara companies that John has been associated with include HG Insights, Invoca, Computer Motion, Citrix Online, Savings.com, RightScale, RevUpNet, Active Life Technologies, Eucalyptus, and AppFolio. He currently serves as executive chairperson for three Santa Barbara startups: CLIQ Products, BuyerCaddy, and Cadense.

As a professor of entrepreneurial studies at UC Santa Barbara, John has taught more than 10,000 students, many of whom have gone on to work in dozens of area startups and established technology companies. In 2012, he received the prestigious Venky Narayanamurti Entrepreneurial Leadership Award from UCSB's College of Engineering, in recognition of his multi-decade impact on Santa Barbara's high-tech community.

For over a decade, John was a regular contributor to *Forbes* and *The Wall Street Journal*, and his work has appeared in *Inc., Entrepreneur* magazine, *TechCrunch*, *Business Insider*, and *TIME*. Dozens of his articles put a national spotlight on Santa Barbara startups and entrepreneurs.

John earned his MBA from Wharton and is a CPA.
