#### Who We Are

The Scholarship Foundation of Santa Barbara inspires, encourages, and supports Santa Barbara County students to and through college, graduate, and vocational school by providing information, advising, and scholarships.

#### Whom We Serve

The Scholarship Foundation supports students of all types throughout their postsecondary studies. Most Scholarship Foundation recipients are first-generation college students, and almost 30 percent receive no financial assistance from their families.

#### Why We Do It

College graduates are generally healthier, more financially secure, and more actively engaged in their communities than their peers possessing a high school diploma alone. And yet, college is prohibitively expensive – and growing more so – for many local families. Since 1962, generous community support has enabled us to award more than \$150 million in scholarships!

## How to Help



#### **Advising & Operations**

#### **Endowed Scholarship Funds**

Endowed Scholarship Funds can be established from gifts of \$100,000 or more, with the option to add to the fund at any time. The Scholarship Foundation then invests the principal and uses the earnings to provide scholarships in perpetuity.

#### **Annual Scholarship Funds**

Annual Scholarship Funds come from individuals, families, businesses, foundations, and civic groups and are managed by the Scholarship Foundation. Starting at \$4,000, donors can establish a named scholarship and retain the flexibility to renew their gift each year.



#### **Planned Gifts**

We invite you to become a member of the Scholars Circle with your planned gift of any amount. Planned gifts can be a great source of satisfaction and may provide tax advantages to you and/or your heirs. We encourage you to work with your financial advisor to determine which assets to give, the best time to give them, and the type of gift arrangement.
